RE: President's Schedule

Friday - May 1, 1970

I suggest we keep this day unscheduled. Perhaps a photograph of the President meeting with Laird, Rogers, and Henry Kissinger -- receiving an up-dated briefing. Whatever is done tomorrow should show the President's involvement in the crisis and point out his deep concern -- but also the confidence that he has in his actions. Perhaps General Wheeler should be included.

Saturday and Sunday

Nothing will be scheduled. I imagine he will follow through with plans for Camp David. Ziegler can say the President is receiving up-dated reports at Camp David.
